What is the Enabling Fund and who can apply?

The Enabling Fund provides financial help to individuals who have the will and motivation to help themselves but lack the essential finance to be able to overcome barriers and hurdles in their way to employment.

The Enabling fund particularly seeks to support people on low income who want to improve their employment prospects.

The Enabling Fund is locally targeted at people living in south Shropshire, specifically the market towns of Ludlow, Craven Arms, Bishop's Castle, Church Stretton and Cleobury Mortimer and the surrounding rural villages and parishes.

We see value in everything, especially people.

The grant

Grants of up to £500 are available, but we will consider applications for larger amounts. The average grant is £250.

Over the years the Enabling Fund has supported:

- √ driving lessons to enable access to work
- ✓ childcare and transport costs to attend an interview.
- ✓ small car repairs or an MOT to get back to work.
- ✓ a suit for an interview
- ✓ trade tools to enable career progression.
- ✓ start up costs for a new business
- ✓ Short term training and educational fees

The Enabling Fund has supported 125 individuals in south Shropshire since 2012.

The Social Return On Investment of the Enabling Fund calculates at an incredible £19.42 for every £1 invested.

The Furniture Scheme manages the Enabling Fund on behalf of the Hall Garth Charitable Trust.

Real life stories from recipients of the Enabling Fund:

Marc, a mature student and father of young children, was unable to continue attending his mental health nursing course due to lack of transport and funds. The Enabling Fund helped him to buy a second hand car and therefore continue his studies. He is now a registered Mental Health Nurse in full time employment.

Rob was in part time employment on minimum wage and struggling to pay his bills and support his children. The Enabling Fund paid for 10 driving lessons to get Rob on the road. Rob quickly passed his test and the fund then helped towards his insurance costs. He was subsequently able to increase his hours to full time and is now flourishing in his work.

Jane, in her forties, was unable to read or write. She had struggled to gain employment and support her young daughter. She had a willingness to learn but lacked the resources to do so. The Enabling Fund has paid for 40 one-on-one literacy lessons for Jane and her reading and writing has greatly improved. She is now in part time employment.
