Once again Shropshire has been dealing with the impact of severe flooding. The effect of floods can be devastating and the Furniture Scheme is well used to supporting people who have lost precious household items. In 2007, when the flooding was perhaps even worse, we were part of a committee to help deal with the aftermath and how to best help the people of Ludlow. The Furniture Scheme supported people through the whole experience of getting back on their feet after the trauma and damage caused by the floods. Now, 13 years on we are again making sure that our services are easy to access and we're happy to help anyone who is facing the uphill battle of furnishing temporary accommodation or refurnishing their flood damaged home with limited funds. Shropshire is fortunate to be home to many altruistic and innovative individuals who are ready and willing to come together at times of crisis to support those who are facing adversity. It is quite likely that extreme weather conditions are going to become increasingly frequent due to the impact of climate change. 
