Since February I have been writing a monthly column for the South Shropshire Journal focussing on the activities of the Furniture Scheme and other local community, voluntary and charitable organisations. I'm still not quite sure why anyone would want to read a column written by me but its great to have a platform to talk about our work as well as the issues facing people and in the area.

One big positive for the Journal is that they have gained at least one new reader – my Mum. So far the columns have been about reuse, loneliness, the impact universal credit and, most recently, gardening. The Rockspring Garden has sprung into action over the last month or so. We now have 6 volunteers who help to grow fruit and vegetables (including far too much Rhubarb!) which can be used in our community lunch, distributed to local people or sold. I'm really pleased that the garden is starting to prove popular and is getting a lot of interest – for the last couple of years it has only survived thanks to the hard work of volunteers Nick and John.

Other parts of the Furniture Scheme which are thriving are the Charity Bookshop and Rockspring Community Centre. Both have had a busy 12 months and the bookshop in particular has brought in much needed income for the Furniture Scheme. Thank you to the volunteers in Craven Arms who help to run this great shop.

At Rockspring, local charity Working Together are settling in very well and we are pleased to be working with such a great organisation. One huge benefit of this is that we have tasty food available from their café 4 days a week (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday 10am-2pm! The Warehouse, Renaissance and Workshop teams have also been busy – all striving to deliver our services to those most in need. Each site plays its part to either directly help the disadvantaged or raise the money to fund our work.

We are lucky to have a group of excellent volunteers working across our sites but we are always looking for more help – van assistants are especially needed. Hello and welcome to the page in the newsletter that keeps you up to date with the exciting "Building better opportunities" (BBO) project at the Furniture Scheme. Nowhere else in the newsletter will you get offered such wonderful opportunities such as: volunteering placements, education and training information, guidance on potentially achieving your employment dreams and an in depth analysis of the greatest rugby team on earth – Wales! I shall spare all the non-Welsh my gloating that we dominated the six nations championship and I probably won't even mention the fact we destroyed the English and there's absolutely no chance of me discussing the fact that Wales are now the six nations champions after completing a Grand Slam of victories over the other nations. So let me talk about something else altogether.

I was recently invited by the Job Centre in Leominster to visit and speak to staff and clients about the BBO project. It was a very successful visit and not only have I begun to forge a close working relationship with the staff at Leominster JCP, but I was also fortunate enough to sign up a few more participants to the project. In fact the day went so well, I have been invited back again and hopefully this will become a regular event, so you may see me there in the future!

Another project that is in the planning stage is the volunteer dog walking project. This will involve volunteers giving up some of their free time to walk the dogs of those who cannot, for a number of reasons, walk their own dog. This project will hopefully go live in 2020 and is only being made possible by the fantastic support of CO-OP. We are very fortunate to have had our project selected by CO-OP as one of their three local causes to receive funds from membership and sales of carrier bags and bags for life. The fundraising lasts a year and so far we have raised over £1000 (it ends in October). CO-OP in Leominster invited me to their store so that I could talk about the project to staff and customers, they were very friendly and they took time out of their busy day to allow me to bend their ears about how passionate I am about walking dogs for those who cannot. Quite often dogs provide company and companionship for those who live alone and without their furry best friend, they would be isolated – this project will not only enable them to keep their dog, but to also get some human contact from another dog lover. I have seen first hand how much of an effect this type of service can have on someone's life and it is nothing short of amazing!

Later this year we shall be looking to recruit volunteers for our dog walking project. We shall provide all the equipment needed along with doggy first aid training, so you are 100% prepared to have a safe and enjoyable time walking dogs. 
