2019 marked the Furniture Scheme's 25th year. An achievement made possible by the generosity, hard work and energy of our volunteers, staff and supporters. The Furniture Scheme has adapted over the past quarter of a century in order to continue to meet the needs of those living in poverty, facing discrimination and seeking to overcome barriers to employment. Survival has at times been a challenge but we are still here! Now part of the Wrekin Housing Group we have been able to enhance our social impact and help more people.

Many of the problems that faced people in 1994 still exist today. At this time of year we see the impact of Christmas on those who have little resources and those dealing with isolation. Christmas should be a time of happiness and companionship but sadly this is not always the case. At the Furniture Scheme we try to help all year round but the value of that help increases during the winter. Rockspring Community Centre is home to Ludlow's Food Bank, free IT access, the Fuel Poverty Fund, community lunches and social activities. People can access low cost gifts such as books and art at our shops, as well as furniture and essential household goods such as bedding and kitchen equipment. Tight budgets are stretched to breaking point at Christmas so if an electrical appliance stops working or furniture is damaged due to flooding or damp it can force people to turn to pay day loans or unaffordable credit options. The work of the Furniture Scheme, along with projects such as NILS (No Interest Loan Scheme), helps to prevent people from finding themselves with spiralling debt.

Over 25 years there have been all sorts of people involved with the Furniture Scheme including a number of passionate and committed staff. Two of our staff have recently left us and we are sad to see them go. Justin Griffiths has been with us as Community Engagement & Volunteer Support Officer for nearly two years and has been an integral part of the Building Better Opportunities project. Graham Lambourn, Volunteer Support Worker, had been one of our longest serving members of staff and helped make the workshop into a very special place for volunteers to learn new skills, overcome challenges and make new friends. Graham made me feel very welcome when I first joined the organisation, as he did for any new arrivals who walked through the door. After working with us for well over a decade he is now retiring.

Thank you to everyone who has supported us over the last 25 years but particularly during 2019. We are looking forward to new developments and ideas in 2020 and we will continue to work with the whole community to make a difference.

I have also been extremely fortunate to have a manager like James, he has recognised how I work best and given me the trust and autonomy to get on with what I do and how I do it, just occasionally tugging on the reins when I get too enthusiastic!

All other staff members have been understanding of the demands I have made of them and once again I appreciate being welcomed into the Furniture Scheme Family and sad to leave.

I shall be leaving at the end of November, a replacement is yet to be named, so keep checking in for up dates – for those of you out there looking for jobs, do not let refusal grind you down, keep positive and keep going, the right job is out there for you somewhere and the BBO project is there to help, so get involved.

After School Homework club is being delivered at the Rockspring centre on **Wednesdays**. We are open to new members, so just turn up and sign in – it's FREE! It's aimed at 8–11 year olds and runs 3.30–5pm during term time.



It's only two years ago that the first Repair Café appeared in Ludlow but already it has become firmly established and its message of not throwing things away unless absolutely necessary is spreading.



A Repair Café is, of course, about repairing and the Café part is enjoying a cup of tea or coffee and mixing with the other people who are there - either the team of volunteer repairers or the other 'customers' who have brought something in to be fixed.

And everything which can be fixed means it lasts a bit longer, therefore avoiding, at least for a while, adding to landfill or being burnt in an incinerator. So it's a double win: not only is there a bit of planet-saving, there is also, of course, money-saving as well!

The team of volunteers never know what they will 'meet' on the day - which is part of the challenge. There is always a wide range, from electrical tools and household items, IT equipment, clocks, jewellery, clothing, radios, bicycles, toys, lamps, gadgets and we are never short of surprises as the photograph of the Dalek shows!

The volunteers greet each challenge with enthusiasm and interest; the owners enjoy watching the repair taking place and the smile on their face when they carry home their mended item is an added reward.

Ludlow's Repair Cafés run four times per year on the last Saturday morning of January, April, July and October, either at the Ludlow Mascall Centre or Rockspring Community Centre, between 10.00 am and 12.30 pm. The next one is on **Saturday 25th January at the Ludlow Mascall Centre**. See flyer on page 13 for further dates throughout the year.

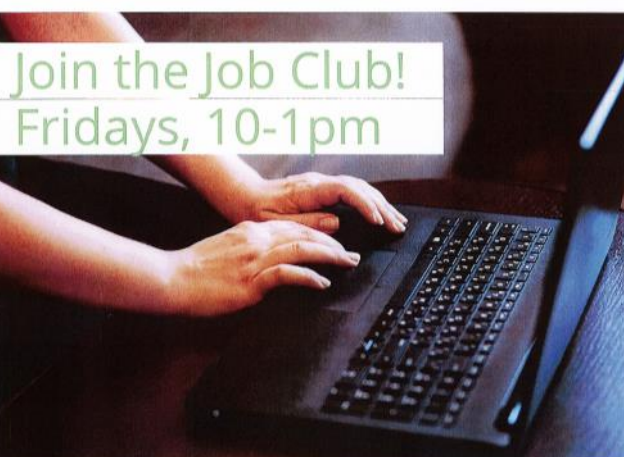
